

Water Based Products

- o Use foam, dry chemical or water spray to extinguish fire.
- Special Fire fighting procedure:
 - o Self contained breathing apparatus and protective clothing should be worn while fighting fires involving chemicals.

Reactivity data

- Stable under recommended handling and storage conditions
- Thermal decomposition may produce carbon mono/ dioxides
- Avoid: Heat, Sparks and Ignition

Health Hazard Data

- In all cases of doubt or when symptoms persist, seek medical attention. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- Contains a low toxic biocide in small amounts
- Skin contact can cause temporary irritation. Remove contaminated clothing, wash skin with soap and water or proprietary skin cleanser and seek medical advice.
- Inhalation: Remove from site to fresh air. If breathing is irregular or stopped administer artificial respiration.
- Eye Contact: can cause irritation. Remove contact lenses. Irrigate thoroughly with clean fresh water, holding eyelids apart and seek medical advice.

Spill, Leak and Disposal Procedure

- Use appropriate safety equipment
- Use absorbent material to collect and contain for disposal
- Contain and collect spill with non-combustible material (sand, earth) and place in a clearly labeled container for

disposal, wash the area with water and detergent.

- Empty cans should be disposed off as per local Government regulations.
- Disposal Method: All local, state and federal regulation concerning health and pollution should be reviewed to determine approved disposal procedures.

Special handling Information-During Usage

Ventilation:

- Local Exhaust: Application should be done in a well ventilated area/
- Respiratory protection: Use respiratory protective equipment to meet regulations in conformity with the control of hazardous substances.
- Can Disposal: as per local regulations
- Protective Clothing: Clean, body covering clothing. In addition rubber gloves, boots and apron can also be used depending upon the exposure likely or as per company rules.
- Eye Protection: Safety goggles recommended.

Storage Conditions

- Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place away from sources of ignition, heat and direct sunlight. There should be no smoking in the area and no unauthorized access.
- Containers that have been opened should be properly resealed and kept upright to prevent leakage.
